



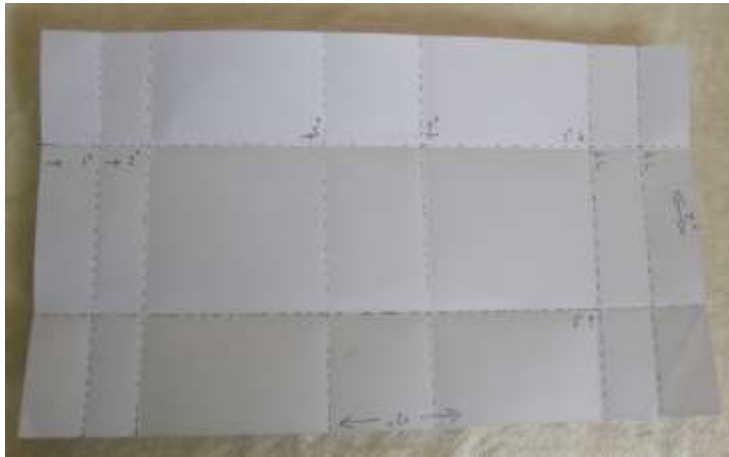
What a Treat!!!

Take an A4 or 12 x 12 sheet of good quality scrapbooking paper and cut down to 7" wide

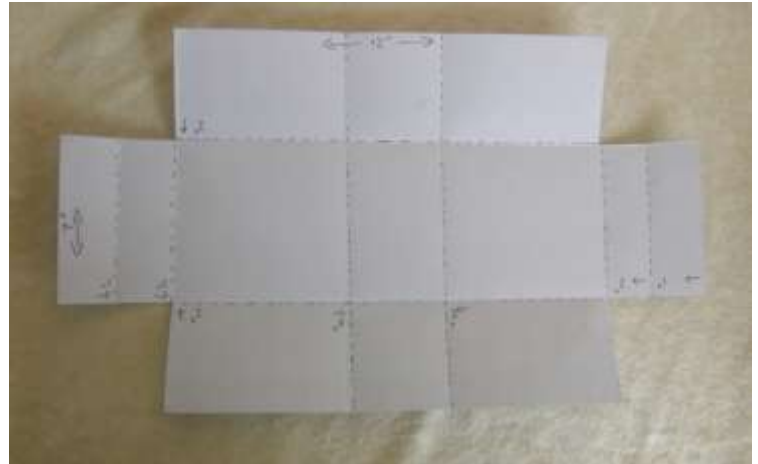
Using your score board (or whatever tool you use to score lines with) and measuring from one short edge score at 1", 2" and 5". Turn the paper 180 degrees and score again at 1" 2" and 5"

Along the long sides of the paper score at 2" in from the edge.

Cut out the corners and fold as shown in the diagrams below.



Score and fold all lines as indicated



Cut out all 4 corners.



If your paper is plain on one side colour with a little ink



Fold each side as shown. Put a little double sided tape as you can see in the picture



Fold one side over the other.



Fold each end down

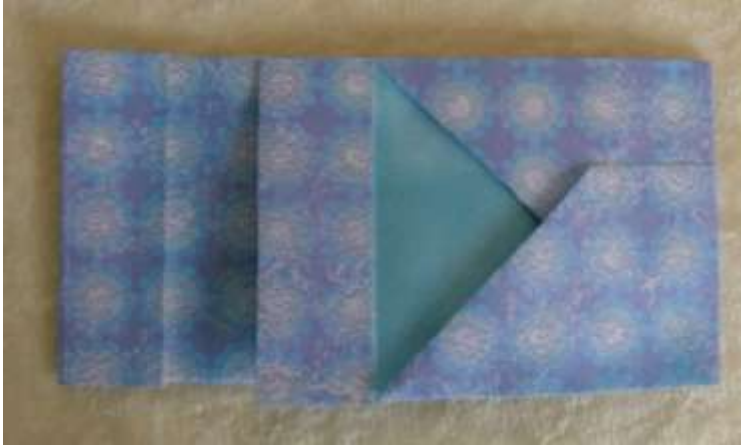


What a Treat!!!

Take an A4 or 12 x 12 sheet of good quality scrapbooking paper and cut down to 7" wide

Using your score board (or whatever tool you use to score lines with) and measuring from one short edge score at 1", 2" and 5". Turn the paper 180 degrees and score again at 1" 2" and 5"

Along the long sides of the paper score at 2" in from the edge. Cut out the corners and fold as shown in the diagrams below.



Fold each side along bottom fold lines



Decorate, cut edges at top and punch holes for ribbon.



Your holder will look like this when folded, simply cut the top at each side and punch holes, for ribbon.



The finished holder can be used to pop in a couple of tea-bags and a cellophane bag with some homemade biscuits.
